When will my tree be planted?

Trees are planted in either the spring or fall. Your tree will be planted at the earliest appropriate season. Scheduling of your tree for planting will be dependent on when your request is received and the availability of the selected tree species.

Provide follow-up care.

Keep the soil moist, but not water-logged. Water trees at least once a week, barring rain, and more frequently during hot weather. When the soil is dry below the surface of the mulch, it is time to water.

The Value of Trees to Lakewood

- Reduce storm water run-off and the cost of water treatment.
- A single mature tree can intercept over 700 gallons of rainfall annually.
- Trees improve water quality and help keep Lake Erie clean.
- Reduce cooling and heating costs.
- Reduce and filter air pollution.
- Generate oxygen.
- Cool streets and sidewalks.
- Provide shade in summer and protect us from winds in the winter.
- Increase property values.
- Provide habitat for birds and other fauna.
- Add living beauty to Lakewood's neighborhoods.
